 - Spirit wear will be open the entire month of October, idea is to come up with another design as well (simpler "Memorial), Ashley will design some ideas and we can vote at a later date
 - Claytime in Shrewsbury will come here for a Pre-holiday family fun night (they do all the work, preorder what you want ahead of time and we can add on a fundraising piece as well, they will fire them and pack them safely and have them ready for pick up and distribution
 - Hoping for another Parent's night out looking at a ConnecteD & Inspire
 - Paint parties, pottery, charcuterie boards (costs \$75 and PTO makes \$15), it's all pre-ordered
 - Santa is busy can see if Friday 12/15 is open, maybe have pick up from the Claytime event at the same time
 - December Raise Right gift card fundraiser (Ashley will head this up)
 - November Square 1 Art (Erin P working with Mrs Fowler)
 - PTO Calendar to see what's coming and it will go home with everyone, goal is for it to go home by the end of September
 - Exploring ways to get information to parents in variety of languages
 - Box Tops Aimee has designed a new flier (will look at other languages as well)
 - Raise Craze 11/1-11/17, a week longer than last year, thinking this year will be more classroom focused vs individuals, hoping to have more kids involved and increase numbers of acts of kindness. We need a theme idea tie the theme into Super Heroes which is the theme for lots of things at Memorial this year, Hoping to have a family kindness event do a food drive and collaborate with Mrs. Guertin's food drive, more specific news about Raise Craze will be available at the next weekend, goal of \$25,000

- Worcester Railers Spirit Night (Stephanie)
 - January 5th will be Spirit Night for Mendon Upton, \$3 per ticket raised, Memorial will have it's own ticket link

- We still have about \$5000 in Scholastic dollars, for this fair we usually take all cash back, teacher credits are purchased with scholastic dollars.

 - Crystal will make sure this happens
